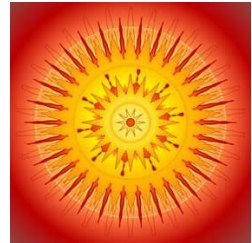

Sources of Information:

The group facilitators utilize resources including books, hand-outs and group discussion. Books can be borrowed from the Family Life Center Library. Session design is flexible in order to address the specific needs of those who are participating.

Class Facilitators: Our group facilitators are Mary Specht and Jan Weber, both of whom are experienced caregivers with training in leading small groups.

FORMAT: Monthly sessions on Sunday afternoons.

Each month our facilitators will cover a topic related to caregiving, through book review, hand-outs and in small group discussion. The experience of group members contributes to the learning process. This group is designed around your concerns!
